




### 1 in 3 Caraga youth has read pornographic materials




### Decline in the prevalence of reading of pornographic materials in the past decade




# Watching x-rated movies/videos is most prevalent among Caraga youth



## Watching x-rated movies/videos has become more prevalent in 2013




### 1 in 7 Caraga youth has viewed websites with sexually-explicit content

  - Philippines: 3.7%









### 2 in 5 youth in Caraga have sexual experience






## Onset of sexual activity has become earlier for both males and females






#### Increased proportions of youth who have engaged in sex before age 18






## Rise in the prevalence of premarital sex in the past decade




## Proportion of Caraga youth who have engaged in PMS is slightly above the national average



## Narrowing gap between male and female premarital sex activity






## More than 4 in 5 of Caraga youth did not use any protection


Withdrawal is the most prevalent contraceptive method used during first PMS among Caraga youth


## Caraga youth have also engaged in other risky sexual activities

- 4% have engaged in casual sex (Philippines: 7%)
- 1.8% have FUBU experience (Philippines: 4%)
- 4.5% of males had sex with a fellow male (MSM) (Philippines: 5%)
- 1.8% of ever-married youth (including those living-in) have extramarital sex experience (Philippines: 3%)
- Most of these risky sexual activities are unprotected against the risk of pregnancy and/or STIs





## Teenage fertility in Caraga more than quadrupled in the past decade






#### Teenage fertility increases with age




Teenage fertility in Caraga is the 4<sup>th</sup> highest in the country








# Low level of knowledge about HIV among Caraga youth

## More than 3 in 5 Caraga youth feel invincible to AIDS




### **SUMMARY & CONCLUSIONS**

- There is a heightened, bolder, and wider range of sexual behaviors among the youth including those that use new forms of information and communication technology (ICT)
- These new technologies have given rise to new forms of sexual activity and new means of meeting sexual partners that could increase the risk of adverse consequences, especially under a context of low prevalence in the use of protection

- Awareness of AIDS is still high but the level has sharply declined in the past decade
  - Caraga has the 4<sup>th</sup> highest level of AIDS awareness among the youth
- Poor knowledge of HIV-AIDS as misconceptions about HIV transmission are still common among the youth
  - Caraga youth are the 4<sup>th</sup> most ignorant that AIDS is incurable
- Majority of the youth think they have immunity from HIV

Of the 488,958 youth in Caraga,

- Nearly 162,000 youth have engaged in premarital sex
  - Of these, more than 138,000 did not use any form of protection during their 1<sup>st</sup> premarital sex
- More than 5,000 youth have commercial sex experience
- Around 20,000 youth have casual sex experience
- Nearly 9,000 youth have FUBU experience

Of the 254,858 male youth in Caraga, more than 11,000 have MSM experience
