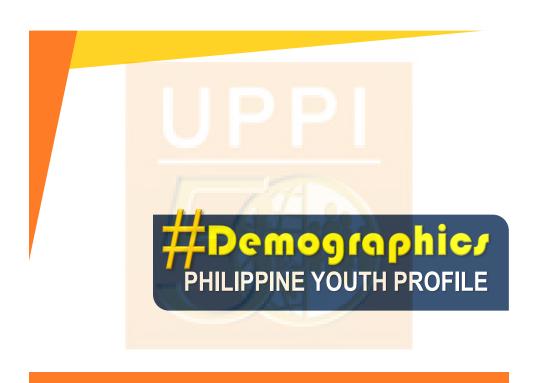

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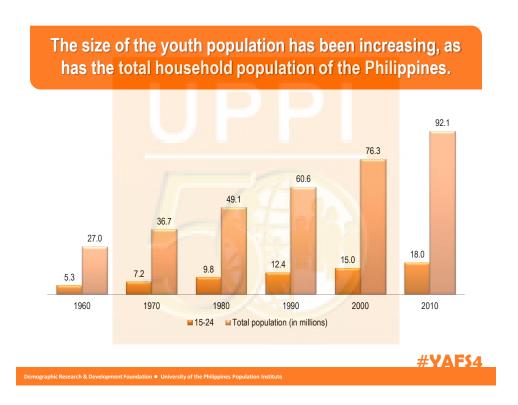
### What is the size of the population 15-24?

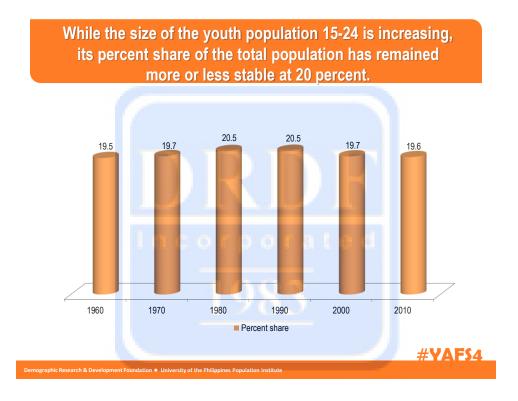
- In 2013, there were

    - 9.0 M were aged 20-24

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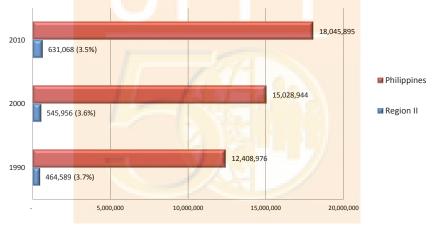
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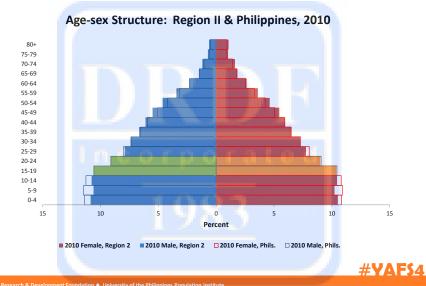
## Number and percent of youth population: Philippines and Region II

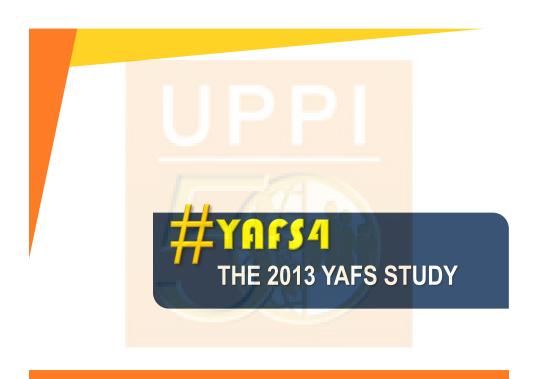
Age 15-24 Population: Region 2 and Philippines, 1990 - 2010

To provide updated information on a broad framework of adolescent sexuality and reproductive health issues, their antecedents, and manifestations that will be useful in the design of interventions to safeguard the health and welfare of Filipino adolescents.

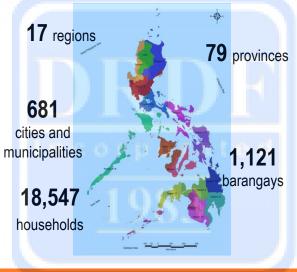

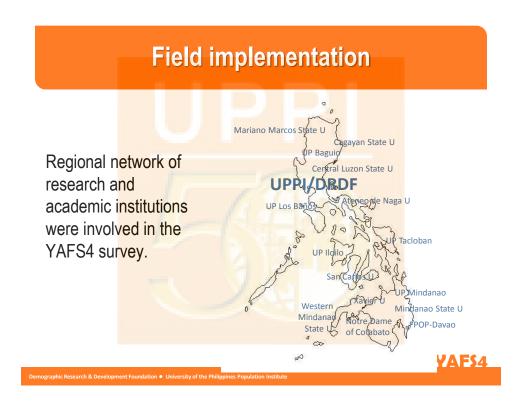

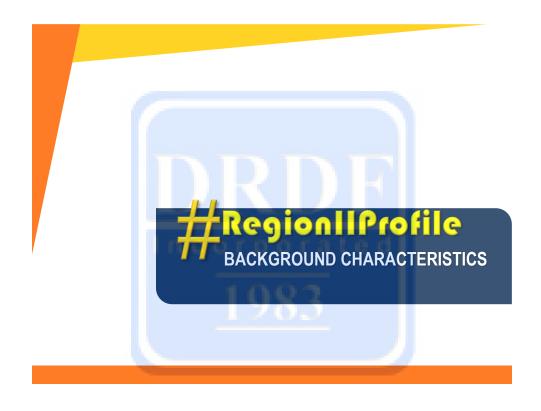
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## Survey design

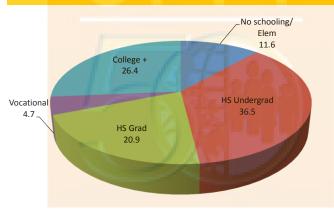
- Sampling domain: Region
- Sample size per region: About 1,000 respondents
- Sampling design:
  - Multistage, stratified random sampling;
  - In each region, barangays were stratified into S, M, L with the size of the youth population as the stratification variable;
  - Within each stratum, barangays were selected with probability proportional to the population size;
  - In each barangay, 15 HHs were selected using systematic random sampling;
  - All eligible members of the sample household (15-24 years old)
     were interviewed.

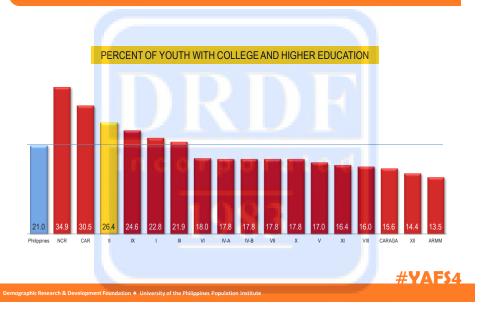


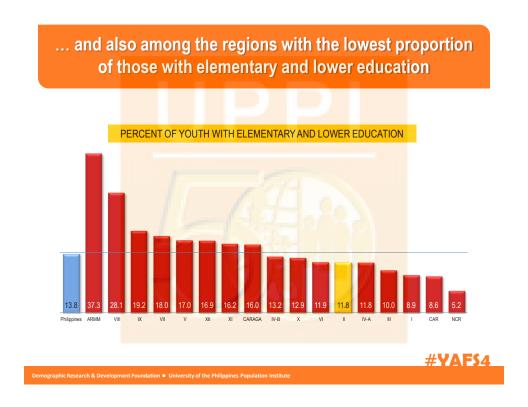


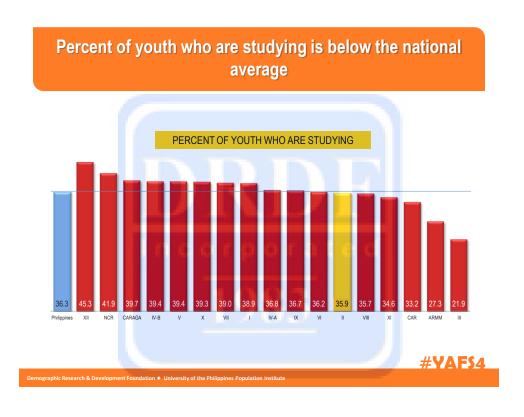
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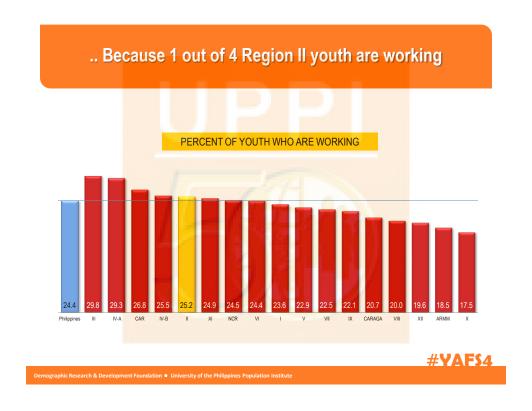
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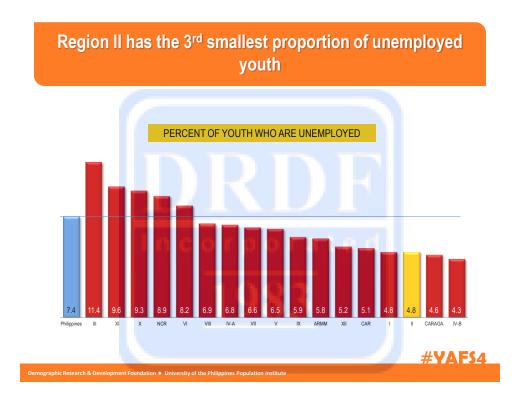
Region II's youth have the third highest proportion of those who have college and higher education

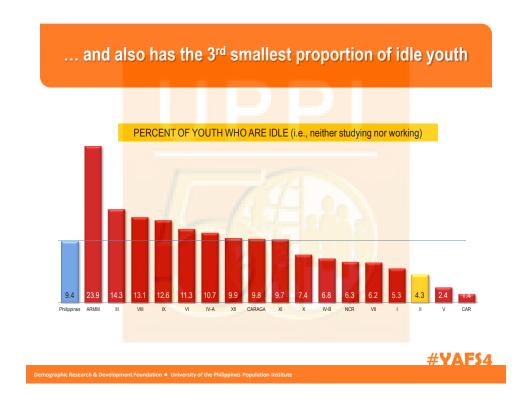


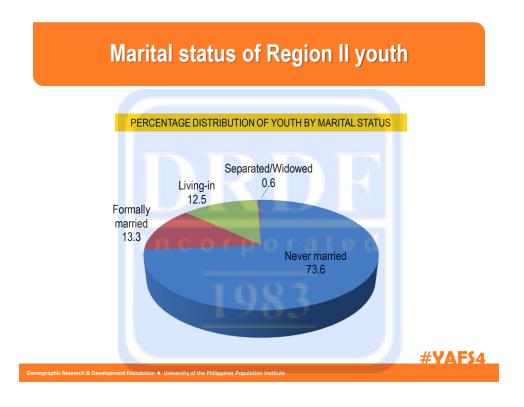


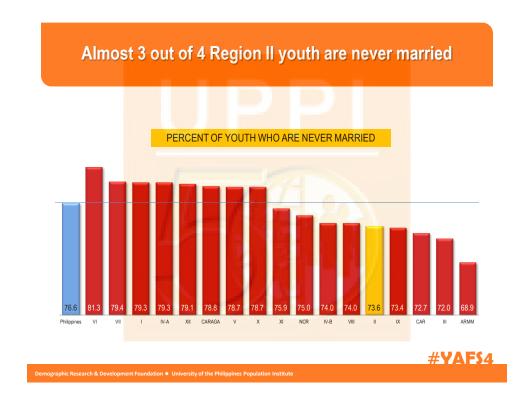


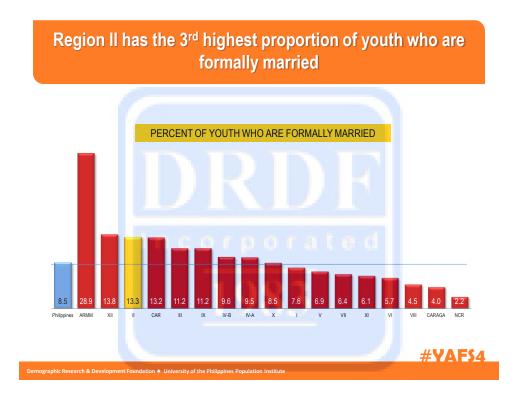


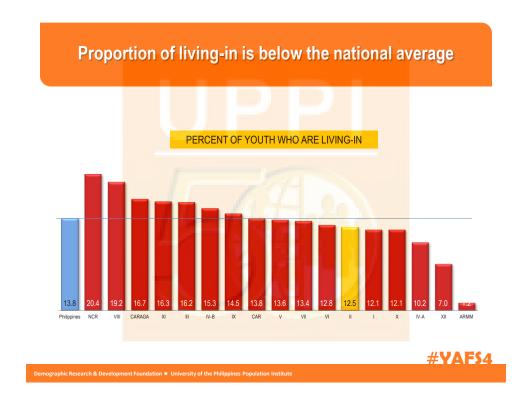














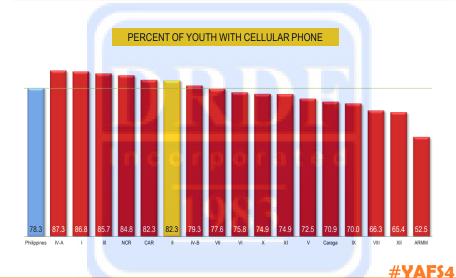
# Low and declining appeal of traditional media among Region II youth

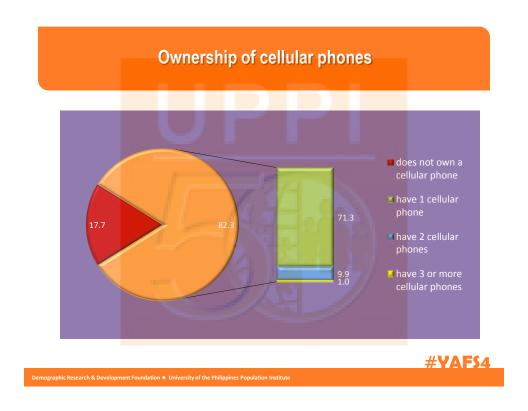
- % who regularly read
  - broadsheet newspapers
    - 14.8% in 2002  $\rightarrow$  6.1% in 2013
  - tabloids
    - 9.2% in 2002  $\Rightarrow$  2.2% in 2013
- % who watch TV regularly
  - 79.4% in 2002 > 75.6% in 2013

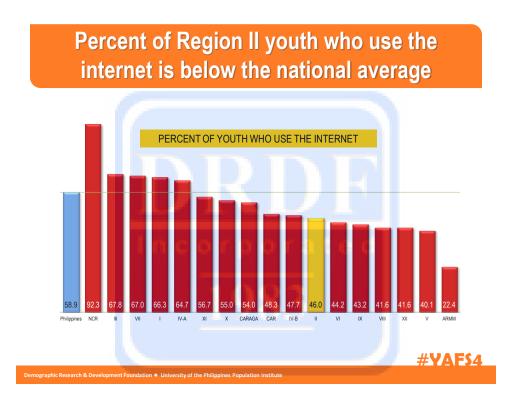
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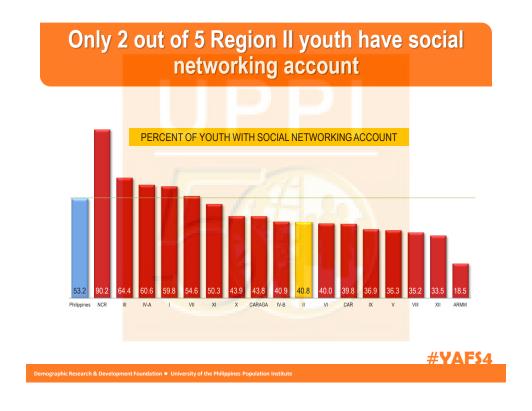
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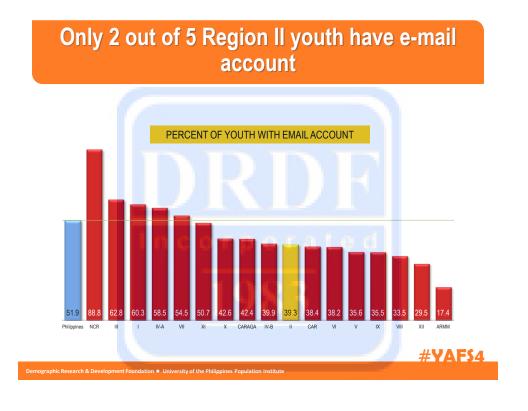

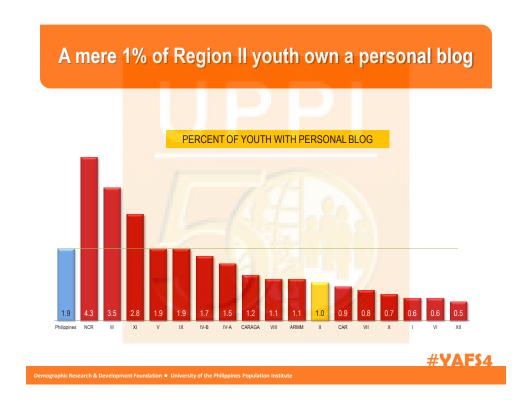


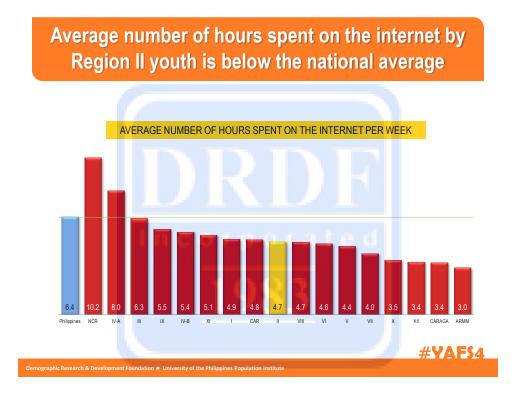




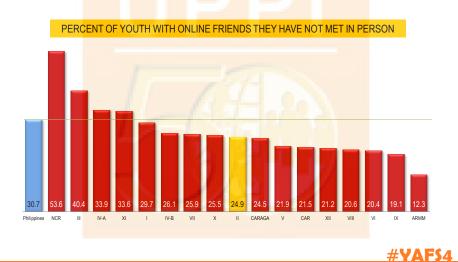






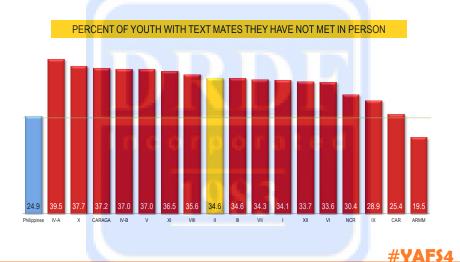


# 1 out of 4 Region II youth have online friends they have not met in person



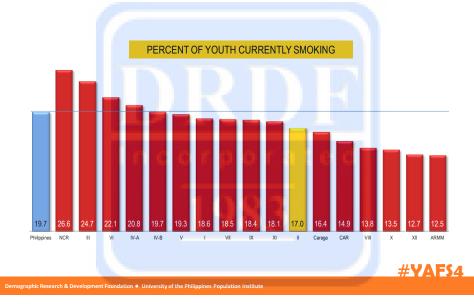
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# 1 out of 3 Region II youth have textmates they have not met in person

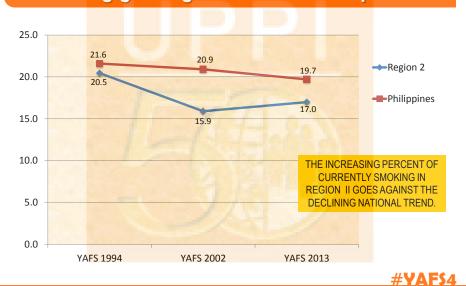






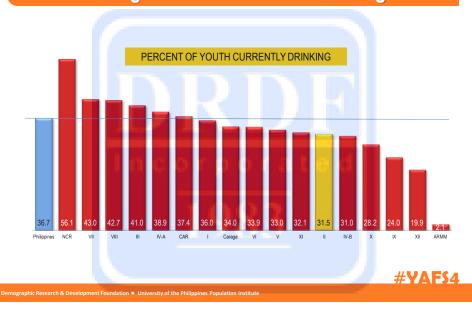


# ...But the trend of the proportion currently smoking goes against the national pattern

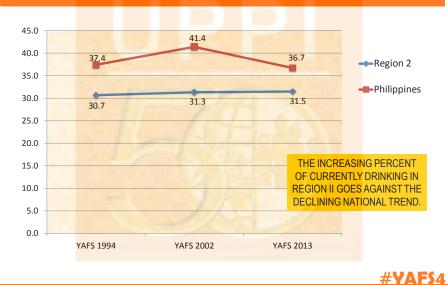


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Region II's proportion of youth who are currently drinking is below the national average







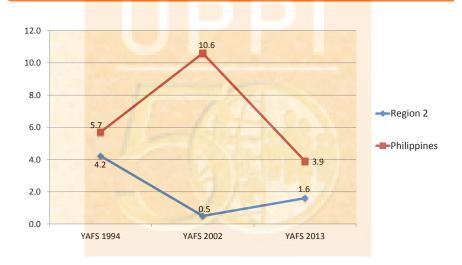
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# Proportion of Region II youth who ever used drugs is below the national average



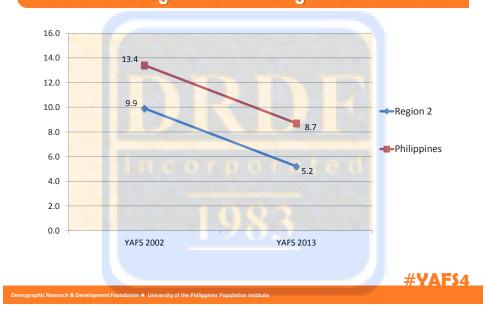
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# ... But the proportion of Region II youth who ever used drugs is also on the rise



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# Between 2002 and 2013, the proportion of youth who ever thought of committing suicide declined

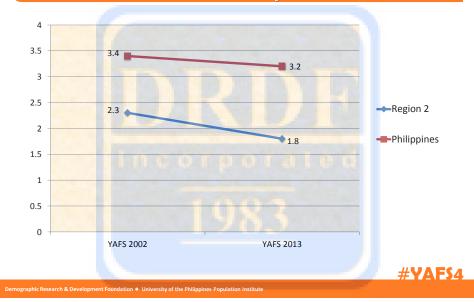


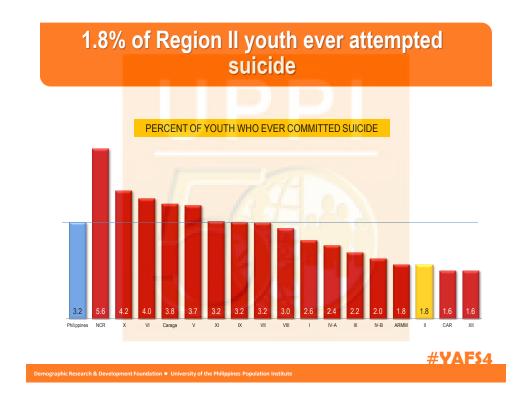


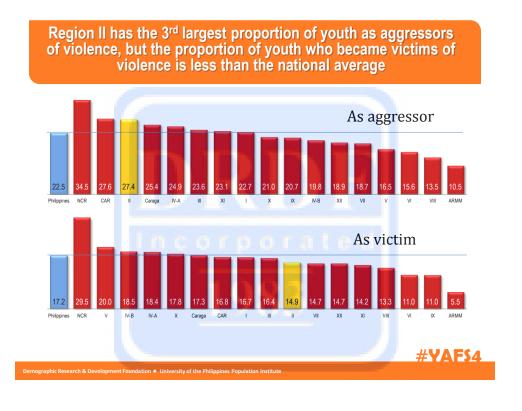


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# Percent who attempted to commit suicide in the past decade...

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#### **SUMMARY**

- Profile of Region II youth:
  - One of the best regional education profiles registering the 3<sup>rd</sup> highest % of youth who have at least some college education;
  - Among the regions with the least proportion of studying youth (6<sup>th</sup>) but among the top regions in terms of the proportion of youth working (5<sup>th</sup>)
  - Has the 3<sup>rd</sup> highest proportion of youth who are formally married (13.3%)

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#### **SUMMARY**

- Media exposure of the Region II youth:
  - Low and declining use of traditional media forms like newspapers and magazines although TV viewership remains high (75.6%)
  - Very high use of new information technology
  - Internet use among Region II youth is less prominent compared to the Philippines as a whole:
    - Internet use (46%)
    - Duration of internet use (4.7 hours/week vs. 6 at the national level)
    - With a social media account (40.8%)
    - With an email account (39.3%)
    - With online friends who they have not met personally (25%)

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#### **SUMMARY**

- Non-sexual risk behaviors of Region II youth:
  - Increasing % of currently smoking and currently drinking youth in the past decade despite the generally declining national trend
  - % of Region II youth who are into certain vices is below the national average:
    - currently smoking (17%)
    - currently drinking (31.5%)
    - Ever used drugs (1.6%)
  - With the second least proportion of youth who ever thought of committing suicide (5.2%)
  - 2.2% of youth ever attempted suicide

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
