




More than 3 in 10 youth have read pornographic materials


Proportion of MIMAROPA youth who have read pornographic materials is below the national level


More males than females read pornographic materials




Proportion of MIMAROPA youth who have watched x-rated videos is below the national level

More males than females watch x-rated videos




MIMAROPA youth have also engaged in other media-related sexual activities

- 0.5% have recorded themselves having sex
 - Philippines: 0.8%
- 4.1% have engaged in sex with someone they met online or through text messages
 - Philippines: 3.7%
- 4.8% have engaged in phone sex
 - Philippines: 5.8%




2 in 5 youth in MIMAROPA have sexual experience


The proportion of sexually experienced MIMAROPA youth is at par with the national level



Sexual debut is happening at younger ages





Younger age at sexual debut among males than females






Almost 1 in 3 MIMAROPA youth has engaged in premarital sex



Increasing prevalence of premarital sex over time





Narrowing gap in levels of premarital sex between males and females



Proportion of MIMAROPA youth who have engaged in premarital sex is at par with the national level




Proportion of MIMAROPA youth who had unprotected first PMS is among the lowest in the country





Low level of commercial sex




MIMAROPA youth have also engaged in other risky sexual activities

- 4.5% have engaged in casual sex (Philippines: 5%)
- 2.5% have FUBU experience (Philippines: 4%)
- 6.5% of males have had sex with a fellow male (MSM) (Philippines: 5%)
- 2.7% of ever-married youth (including those living-in) have extramarital sex experience (Philippines: 3%)
- Most of these risky sexual activities are unprotected against the risk of pregnancy and/or STIs


Teenage fertility increased in the past decade


Teenage fertility generally increases with age


Teenage fertility in MIMAROPA is among the lowest in the country


1 in 4 MIMAROPA female teens do not know that a woman can get pregnant from one unprotected sex



More male teens than female teens have misconceptions about conception






Awareness of AIDS among MIMAROPA youth is higher than the national level



Declining level of AIDS awareness among the youth




Misconceptions about HIV transmission are common among MIMAROPA youth


Knowledge about HIV among MIMAROPA youth is among the lowest in the country




Proportion of MIMAROPA youth who discuss HIV-AIDS with other people is 3rd highest in the country

SUMMARY & CONCLUSIONS

- Filipino youth displays a heightened, bolder, and wider range of sexual behaviors including those that use new forms of information and communication technology (ICT)
 - MIMAROPA youth are relatively low users of modern ICT to access sexually-explicit materials
 - Risky sexual activities are not as pervasive among MIMAROPA youth compared to their counterparts in other regions

SUMMARY & CONCLUSIONS

- Most of the sexual activities are unprotected against the risk of unplanned pregnancy and STIs
 - Nearly 8 in 10 MIMAROPA youth did not use any form of protection during their premarital sexual initiation
- MIMAROPA posted the 5th lowest teenage fertility level among all regions in the country
 - Of the estimated 156,000 females age 15-19 in the region, around 19,000 have already begun childbearing

SUMMARY & CONCLUSIONS

- Although MIMAROPA is among the regions with high awareness of AIDS, the level is low and declining in the past 2 decades
- There is poor knowledge of HIV-AIDS as misconceptions about HIV transmission still abound among the youth
- MIMAROPA has the 3rd highest proportion of youth who feel that they have immunity from HIV

SUMMARY & CONCLUSIONS

- Of the estimated 570,000 youth in MIMAROPA in 2013,
 - Around 179,000 youth have engaged in premarital sex
 - Of these, around 138,000 did not use any form of protection during their 1st premarital sex
 - Around 9,000 youth have commercial sex experience
 - Nearly 26,000 youth have casual sex experience
 - Around 14,000 youth have FUBU experience
- Of the estimated 290,000 male youth, more than 19,000 have MSM experience

SUMMARY & CONCLUSIONS

Future interventions for the youth in MIMAROPA will do well to be guided by the YAFS4 results, both in the sexual and non-sexual risk behaviors as the findings of the study reflect who today's generation of MIMAROPA youth are, based on empirical results from a survey with a rigorous methodology.
