






3 in 10 Region IX youth have read pornographic materials




Decline in the prevalence of reading of pornographic materials in the past decade




More than half of Region IX youth have watched x-rated movies and videos



The prevalence of watching x-rated movies/videos has risen in the past decade for both males and females




14 in 100 Region IX youth who have visited websites with sexually-explicit content

Almost 1 in 5 Region IX youth has shared sex videos online or through cellphones





Region IX youth have also engaged in other media-related sexual activities

 Philippines: 5.8%
- 3% have engaged in sex with someone they met online or through text messages
 - Philippines: 3.7%
- 0.6% has recorded themselves having sex
 - Philippines: 0.8%




2 IN 5 youth in Region IX have sexual experience







Age of onset of sexual activity is decreasing for males




Substantial increase in early sexual activity among males but decline among females in the past decade




Sharp increase in the proportions of youth who have engaged in sex before age 18




More than 1 in 3 Region IX youth have engaged in premarital sex



Sharp rise in the prevalence of premarital sex in Region IX in the past decade










Region IX ranks 5th in prevalence of premarital sex




Region IX has the highest prevalence of unprotected 1st PMS among the youth




Condom and withdrawal are the most popular contraceptive method used during first PMS



Region IX youth have also engaged in other risky sexual activities


- 6.2% have engaged in casual sex (Philippines: 7%)
- 2.5% have FUBU experience (Philippines: 4%)
- 3.1% have experienced sex with the same sex (Philippines: 5%)
- 1.6% of ever-married youth (including those living-in) have extramarital sex experience (Philippines: 3%)
- Most of these risky sexual activities are unprotected against the risk of pregnancy and/or STIs



Teenage fertility in Region IX has steeply risen in the past decade




The proportion of teenage females in Region IX who have begun childbearing increases with age



16 in 100 teen females in Region IX have already begun childbearing






Common misconceptions about conception



The proportion with correct knowledge does not consistently increase with education. There is a gap in knowledge about reproduction at all levels of education






8 in 10 Region IX youth are aware of AIDS






Moderate level of knowledge regarding HIV transmission prevention methods


Knowledge of HIV transmission of Region IX youth lower than national level







SUMMARY & CONCLUSIONS

- There is a heightened, bolder, and wider range of sexual behaviors among the youth including those that use new forms of information and communication technology (ICT)
- These new technologies have given rise to new forms of sexual activity and new means of meeting sexual partners that could increase the risk of adverse consequences, especially under a context of low prevalence in the use of protection
 - 92% of Region IX youth who had PMS did not use any protection against pregnancy or STIs, the highest level in the country



- The increased prevalence of sexual activity in various forms may indicate new normative standards regarding sex
 - Norms around marriage may also be changing as indicated by a higher proportion of the living-in than the formally married not only in Region IX but in the rest of the country
- The fact that young women in Region IX have caught up with their male counterparts in sexual activity is likely a major contributor to the sharp increase in teenage fertility

SUMMARY & CONCLUSIONS

- Awareness of AIDS is high but the level has declined in the past decade
- Poor knowledge of HIV-AIDS as misconceptions about HIV transmission are still common among the youth
- Majority of the youth think they will not get HIV
