


What is the size of the population 15-24?

- In 2013, there were
 - 19.3 M youth in the Philippines
- Of these,
 - **10.3 M** were aged 15-19
 - 9.0 M were aged 20-24


The size of the youth population has been increasing, as has the total household population of the Philippines.


Number and percent of youth population: Philippines and Region X





Survey design

- Sampling domain: Region
- Sample size per region: About 1,000 respondents
- Sampling design:
 - Multistage, stratified random sampling;
 - In each region, barangays were stratified into S, M, L with the size of the youth population as the stratification variable;
 - Within each stratum, barangays were selected with probability proportional to the population size;
 - In each barangay, 15 HHs were selected using systematic random sampling;
 - All eligible members of the sample household (15-24 years old) were interviewed.

Field implementation

Regional network of research and academic institutions were involved in the YAFS4 survey.






Education profile of Region X youth






Region X has the lowest proportion of working youth


Region X ranks 3rd in unemployment among the youth








Marital status of Region X youth










Region X youth are highly mobile





3 in 4 youth own a cellular phone




More than 1 out of 2 Region X youth use the internet






























Proportion of Region X youth who are currently smoking is the 3rd lowest in the country


The proportion currently smoking is sharply declining


Proportion currently drinking is the 4th lowest in the country




Region X has the 2nd biggest proportion of youth who have ever used drugs



Between 2002 and 2013, the proportion of youth who ever thought of committing suicide declined





Still, 11 in 100 Region X youth have thought of committing suicide





Percent who attempted to commit suicide in the past decade declined







SUMMARY

- Profile of Region X youth:
 - Average education profile registering 39.3% of youth who are studying and 17.8% of youth who have at least some college education;
 - Has the lowest % of working youth (17.5) and the 3rd biggest % of unemployed youth (9.3)
 - % of currently living-in youth exceeds that of formally married youth

SUMMARY

- Media exposure of Region X youth:
 - High use of new information technology
 - Internet use is prominent among the youth:
 - Internet use (55%)
 - Duration of internet use (3.5hours/week vs. 6.4 at the national level)
 - With a social media account (43.9%)
 - With an email account (42.6%)
 - With online friends who they have not met personally (25.5%)
 - 37.7% have textmates they have not met in person

SUMMARY

- Non-sexual risk behaviors of Region X youth:
 - Decreasing % of currently smoking, currently drinking, and drug-using youth in the past decade, resembling the national trend
 - % who are smoking and drinking are below the national average:
 - Currently smoking (13.5%)
 - currently drinking (28.2%)

But % who ever used drugs is the 2nd biggest in the country

- Ever used drugs (8%)
- Proportion of youth who ever thought of committing suicide: 11.3% (vs. 8.7 at the national level)
- 4.2% of youth ever attempted suicide, the 2nd highest in the country
