









Nearly 3 in 5 Region XI youth have watched x-rated movies and videos





Region XI youth ranks 5th in viewing websites with sexually-explicit content






Region XI youth have also engaged in other media-related sexual activities


- 0.9% has recorded themselves having sex





2 IN 5 youth in Region XI have sexual experience












Increasing proportions of youth who have engaged in sex before age 18





Almost 2 in 5 Region XI youth have engaged in premarital sex




Almost 2 in 5 Region XI youth have engaged in premarital sex












8 in 10 of Region XI youth's 1st premarital sex were unprotected against pregnancy and/or STIs





Decline in the proportion of youth who have paid for sex; Rise in the proportion who have received payment for sex






- 6.3% have engaged in casual sex (Philippines: 7%)
- 4.0% have FUBU experience (Philippines: 4%)
- 6.4% of males have had sex with a fellow male (MSM) (Philippines: 5%)
- 2.6% of ever-married youth (including those living-in) have extramarital sex experience (Philippines: 3%)
- Most of these risky sexual activities are unprotected against the risk of pregnancy and/or STIs





















Awareness of AIDS among Region XI youth has declined in the past 2 decades





SUMMARY & CONCLUSIONS

- There is a heightened, bolder, and wider range of sexual behaviors among the youth including those that use new forms of information and communication technology (ICT)
- These new technologies have given rise to new forms of sexual activity and new means of meeting sexual partners that could increase the risk of adverse consequences, especially under a context of low prevalence in the use of protection



SUMMARY & CONCLUSIONS

- The increased prevalence of sexual activity in various forms may indicate new normative standards regarding sex
 - Norms around marriage may also be changing as indicated by a higher proportion of the living-in than the formally married not only in Region XI but in the rest of the country as well
- The narrowing of the gap in the prevalence of premarital sexual (PMS) activity between young men and women, amidst increasing PMS prevalence in general, is likely a major contributor to the sharp increase in teenage fertility



SUMMARY & CONCLUSIONS

Of the 960,000 youth in Region 11,

- 370,000 youth have engaged in premarital sex
 - Of these, 295,000 did not use any form of protection during their 1st premarital sex
- Nearly 23,000 youth have commercial sex experience
- Around 60,000 youth have casual sex experience
- Nearly 40,000 youth have FUBU experience
- More than 30,000 male youth have MSM experience
- Nearly 42,000 teenage females have begun childbearing
